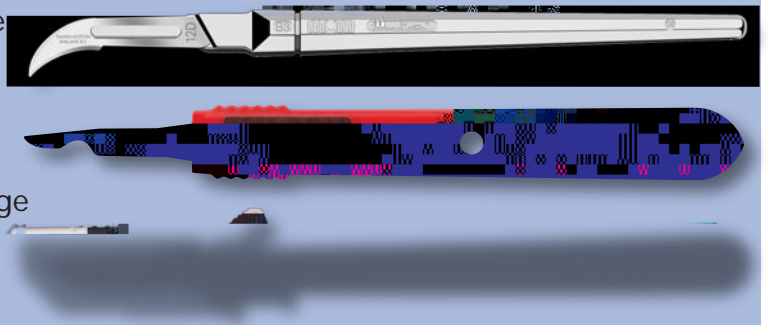

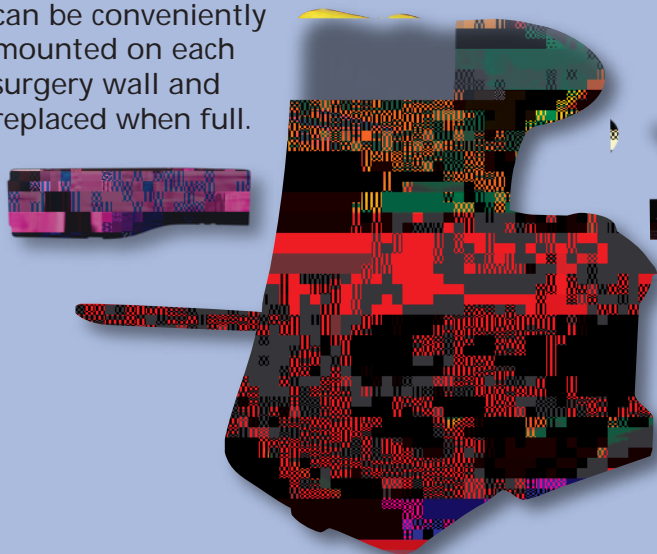

The Sharps Directive compliant sterile retractable safety scalpel supports existing safety protocols whilst encouraging safe handling and disposal of sharps within the dental practice. Originally available in blade shapes, 10, 11P and 15 which are colour-coded for ease of recognition the range has now been extended to include the 12 and 15c. Unit boxes of 10 have also been launched in addition to the original boxes of 25.



The single use sterile blade remover assists in the safe removal of a contaminated surgical blade from the traditional metal surgical handles as does the Clicksmart "BladeFLASK EVO" which can be conveniently mounted on each surgery wall and replaced when full.



The "Cygnetic" range combines a thicker stainless steel blade with a special innovative handle which grips the blade firmly on both sides providing additional lateral strength. The system minimises the handling of the blade when fitting and removing from the handle.
